Where are we going to stay?

That often is the first question asked when planning a vacation. Fortunately in Santa Rosa County there are a variety of options.

Short-term visitors often opt for a hotel. Navarre features several budget-friendly options including the Best Western, located directly on the Santa Rosa Sound off Hwy. 98. Directly across the street is the Days Inn which also boasts a small conference center. The newest addition is the Hampton Inn and Suites, popular with business travelers and vacationing families alike.

On Navarre Beach more than a half-dozen vacation rental companies offer townhouses, beach cottages and condominiums for short and long-term stays. Many require a three-night minimum, and discounts generally are offered for week-long visits. Vacation rentals are popular with today's travelers who often like the convenience of having a kitchen to prepare some or all meals. Most also offer recreational amenities such as resort swimming pools, recreation rooms and more.

In northern Santa Rosa County, leisure travelers and corporate types enjoy the wooded cabins and Schoolhouse Inn at Adventures Unlimited. Nightly rentals are available, but advanced reservations are recommended as units often fill in peak months.

Several hotels are also located conveniently off I-10 giving visitors easy access to the many outdoor activities in northern and southern parts of Santa Rosa County.

RV travelers will find several options. In Navarre, there are three RV parks located on the water including the Navarre Beach Campground, Emerald Beach RV Resort and Magnolia Beach Campground. Amenities include modern restrooms and shower facilities, WIFI, swimming pools, recreation rooms and most have planned activities for guests.

Northern Santa Rosa County is a popular destination for outdoor enthusiasts who enjoy a wooded setting. There are more than a half-dozen options including the Milton Gulf Pines KOA conveniently located just off I-10 to tent camping in the Blackwater River State Forest. A popular destination is Adventures Unlimited just East of Milton where campers find a host of activities including canoeing, kayaking and rafting to a modern ropes course, hiking and biking.
