

## **ART ALONG THE BEACHES TO RIVERS OF SANTA ROSA**

Art and theatre lovers will enjoy Santa Rosa County's growing arts community.

The Santa Rosa Arts and Culture Foundation, Inc., was formed in 2004 and was designated as the Arts Agency for Santa Rosa County. The Dragonfly Gallery is the mission of the Santa Rosa Art and Culture Foundation created specifically to help artists promote their works of art by giving them a place to showcase their work, educate those interested in their medium by holding public workshops, and to house receptions for the artists to meet and greet the public. The Dragonfly Gallery is located in Historic Downtown Milton.

The Panhandle Community Theatre offers a variety of productions and workshops throughout the year. The volunteer organization stages many of their events at the historic Imogene Theatre in downtown Milton.

Monthly Gallery Nights are held at Dovetails Art and Frame in Navarre. Featured artists showcase their work each month and Gallery Night visitors enjoy free wine tastings and live music.

Holley Hill Pottery features the work of world-renowned potter Brenda Stokes and her husband, Marty and son, Jason. The trio utilize a 32' wood-fueled Anagama kiln and also are active in the Gulf Coast Kiln Walk Society which is dedicated to the development and education of wood fired pottery.

Special art events are held throughout the year in conjunction with the annual Navarre Fun Fest held in May at Navarre Beach and month-long Beaches to Woodlands Tour held throughout Santa Rosa County each October.
